We continue in the Epiphany Season, high-lighted by the call of Jesus to follow him and become his disciples. None of us has chosen to be a disciple of Jesus; we each responded to his call. He chose us first. Some disciples in those early years were personally invited by Jesus. Others were welcomed by other disciples. To be a disciple of Jesus is to be given the task of inviting others to join the fun and mission. We don't have to follow Jesus; we get to! We might not know everything it means to be a disciple. But, hang on. Along the way of discipleship, Jesus promises to gradually open our eyes to who he really is and what he really wants.

I have long said that I don't always need answers. And, I don't always need advice. But I do need Jesus always. If all we needed in life was knowledge, then God would have just
